We would like to advise members of the public that the airport depicted in the pictures is not of the Kenneth Kaunda International Airport Terminal 2. KKIA Terminal 2 is still under construction and is currently 77 per cent complete.

The current construction progress at KKIA is as follows:

Hotel	67%
Air Traffic Control Tower	86%
Presidential Pavilion	78%
Cargo Terminal	85%
Commercial Complex-Airport Shopp Mall and Airport Office park	ing 45 %

The overall completion is at 70% and the completion date is October 2019.
